These two artists perfectly encapsulate the genre-busting spirit of the "Performa 11" biennial. In "Love Letters in Ancient Brick," her first work for the stage, the Swiss-born artist Mai-Thu Perret collaborated with the French neo-minimalist choreographer Laurence Yadi.
